Applications are invited for empanelment of candidates to engage his/her services on adhoc/contract basis or hourly basis against regular/leave vacancy in Atomic Energy Central School, OSCOM for the academic session 2019-20 for various posts. Eligible and experienced candidates may appear for written test followed by skill test.

Details of the post, educational and teaching qualifications required are given below. Qualifying degree/diploma should be from recognized university with minimum 50% marks for General and 45% marks (for SC/ST/OBC/PH):

**NOTE:-**

1. For TGT Rs. 26,250/- (Consolidated) per month, or @ Rs.210/- per period depending upon work load.
2. Age relaxation of 5years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC and 10years for female Candidates. If a person is eligible for more than one concession only one concession with highest relaxation limit will be granted.
3. All the candidates should bring copy of residence proof (Ration Card, Aadhar Card or any other valid document) passport size photograph and Xerox copies of the certificate/testimonials along with originals at the time of interview.
4. All the candidates should be competent to teach through **English medium**.
5. Three years teaching experience and working knowledge of computer is desirable.
6. Panel will be operated as and when vacancy arises in the academic year **2019-20**.
7. Qualification pertaining to B.Ed and CTET may be relaxed in case of suitable candidate (subject to approval from competent authority).

**Mode of Selection:** Selection involves two steps

i. **Written Test-** The screening shall be made through objective type (MCQs) examination pattern of 50 marks in respective subject for 1 hour. Candidates scoring 50% or above (Gen) and 45% or above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) will be considered for skill test.

ii. **Skill Test-** For the candidates short-listed on the basis of written test.

No **TA/DA** shall be paid for attending the written test and skill test.
